



Camp Fortune Employment Opportunities

Camp Fortune has many full-time and part-time employment opportunities available on a seasonal basis. Camp Fortune employees enjoy the benefit of a fun, team environment and free skiing or snowboarding for the season. Part-time employees would expect to work 16-20 hours/week and full-time employees work 36-40 hours/week with wages based on experience. All candidates should be bilingual.

The descriptions below give a brief overview of the positions available and we invite you to complete an application form and provide your resume by mail or fax. If selected, you will be contacted in mid-November to schedule an interview.

Rental Shop:

Cashier:

Responsible for daily equipment rental sales; replenishing counter with forms and brochures; balance lift ticket sales; answer telephone. Cashier is accountable for cash-out at the end of their shift and other duties as required.

Clerk:

Responsible to greet and assist customers through the equipment rental process, fit and supply customers with ski or snowboard boots, help maintain and clean equipment and shop area.

Tech:

Responsible to help train and certify employees for ski binding adjustments; mount bindings on skis and snowboards during pre-season start-up and adjust equipment for all customers, staff and guests. Keep equipment inventory and maintain necessary stock of all tools.

Customer Service:

Cashier/Clerk:

Responsible to sell lift tickets and seasons passes; answer phone and provide information to customers/guests; will require knowledge of all lesson programs, services and facilities offered by Camp Fortune; accountable for cash-out at end of shift.

Ticket Booth Cashier/Clerk:

Responsible to sell lift tickets; provide information to customers/guests; will require knowledge of services and facilities offered by Camp Fortune; accountable for cash-out at end of shift.

Skiing in Schools Coordinator:

Responsible to coordinate the skiing in schools program including promotion of the program to schools, act as liaison between teachers and Camp Fortune; process group reservations including lift tickets, lesson programs and rental equipment.

Food And Beverage Department:

Cashier:

Responsible for efficient service of customers in cafeteria; maintain inventory of products in cafeteria; maintain workstation and be accountable for cash-out at the end of their shift. (evenings & weekends)

Runners:



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Responsible to maintain cleanliness of eating areas; help maintain inventory of products in cafeteria (evenings and weekends)

Kitchen Staff:

Responsible to assist chef and staff in necessary tasks within the kitchen including dishwashing, food preparation and cleaning.

Maintenance Department:

Snowmaking Personnel: Responsible for early season and overnight operation of the snowmaking equipment. Night shift work, must be reliable; technically inclined and able to work with limited supervision

Lift Operators:

Responsible for the professional loading of customers onto and off of chairlifts and t-bar lifts. Must be reliable, able to communicate with customers/guests of the resort and able to work in other areas of the maintenance department when necessary.

Outdoor Operations: Reliable, technically inclined personnel, able to communicate with customers /guests of the resort in a number of possible situations, including acting as parking attendants; lift operators; general maintenance.

Camp Fortune Ski and Snowboard Academy
